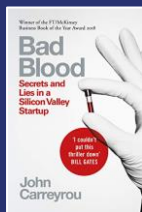

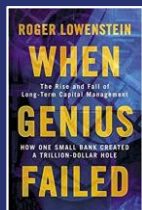

### Bad Blood: Secrets and Lies in a Silicon Valley Startup, John Carreyou

In *Bad Blood*, Carreyou covers the spectacular rise and collapse of the multibillion-dollar startup Theranos. In 2014, founder and CEO Elizabeth Holmes was widely seen as the female Steve Jobs: a brilliant Stanford dropout whose startup "unicorn" promised to revolutionize the medical industry by making blood tests faster and easier. The problem was, the technology didn't work. A must-read for anyone who wants to improve their understanding of how to uncover companies conducting illicit business practices.



### When Genius Failed: The Rise and Fall of Long-Term Capital Management, Lowenstein

When it was founded in 1993, Long-Term was hailed as the most impressive hedge fund in history. But after four years in which the firm dazzled Wall Street as a \$100 billion moneymaking juggernaut, it suddenly suffered catastrophic losses that jeopardized not only the biggest banks on Wall Street but the stability of the financial system itself. The dramatic story of Long-Term's fall is now a chilling harbinger of the crisis that would strike all of Wall Street, from Lehman Brothers to AIG, a decade later.
